

Speyside

- Aberlour 10 YO** 25ml £4.50
Matured in a combination of ex-bourbon and sherry casks, this 10-year old remains a perennial favourite, typical of the modern Speyside style and thoroughly approachable.
- Beinn Dubh** £5.80
Dark fruits, some woodsmoke and a kind of dry, black treacle note on the nose with cinnamon, blackstrap molasses and treacle on the palate.
- Balvenie 12 YO** £5.00
Deep amber in colour. Re-racked in Oloroso sherry casks to give a sherry nose with a nutty, malty finish.
- Balvenie 14 YO** £6.00
Matured for 14 years in traditional oak casks before being transferred to Caribbean rum casks to create a well-rounded and drinkable whisky with notes of fruit and vanilla.
- Cardhu 12 YO** £5.00
Shows a good body, sweet and rich. Streaks of smoke, apple peel and pear. The palate is smooth, rounded and gentle. On the finish – long, dry smoke and a malty touch of peat.
- Cragganmore 12 YO** £5.00
A rich, slightly floral whisky with barley notes on the nose. A strong, malty taste with hints of sweet wood smoke and sandalwood followed by a long, malt-driven finish with light smoke and hints of sweetness.
- Glenfarclas 10 YO** £4.50
Home to an independent family since 1865, in the valley of the green grass, this is a firm, slightly smoky malt. Dry at first and then blossoming into a sweet, long finish.
- Glenfarclas 15 YO** £6.00
With great age comes great complexity. A prime balance of sherry, oak and smokiness makes this a superb malt.
- Glenfarclas 105** £6.00
The strongest malt offered by any distillery. Full bodied and rich with nuances of butterscotch and raisins followed by a long, powerful finish boosted by the strength of the cask.
- Glenlivet Founder's Reserve** £4.40
Full gold in colour, the nose is mellow and sophisticated, backed by a sweet, biscuity note with a remote and elusive fragrance that becomes more floral at reduced strength.
- Glenfiddich 12 YO** £4.50
The valley of the deer gives its name to this global big seller. Light in style with sweet, fruity notes and a hint of pear on the nose followed with a trace of smokiness in its aromatic flavour.
- Glenfiddich 15 YO** £5.10
This medium-bodied malt supports the Christmas pudding flavours – sherry, raisins, fruitcake, spices and sweetness – preceding an oaky finish.
- Glenfiddich IPA** £5.00
Vibrant with a zesty citrus note followed by creamy vanilla and a hint of fresh hops.
- Glenfiddich Project XX** £5.00
Lots of wood: cloves, cinnamon and vanilla with tingy wood tannins, all wrapped up with sweet fudge notes.
- Glenfiddich Fire & Cane** £5.00
Like a Highland peat campfire, with oak notes and toffee. Sharp green fruit, sweet baked apple and soft smoke.
- Knockando 12 YO** £4.50
Fragrant and smooth with a delightful, flowery, nutty sweetness it leaves the palate clean with evanescent, smoky, dry notes.
- Macallan Double Cask** £4.90
Citrus and boiled sweets rule the palate, along with hints of ginger and cinnamon, while soft oak tones reveal toasted apples. The finish is medium-sweet, malty and slightly dry.

Monkey Shoulder £4.50
A smooth, creamy, supple and very malty with a suggestion of berries. Juicy, toasted barley, cloves and butterscotch. Medium length finish with spicy oak and a hint of peppermint on the tail.

Singleton of Dufftown £4.90
Flavours of orange zest, oak and spice enhanced by lingering, fruity touches.

Tamdhu 10 YO £4.90
The softness of vanilla and sugared almonds is balanced by fresh oak and cinnamon. Bursting with fruit and spice, gently yielding to toffee and rich sherry oak. Fruit and vanilla linger becoming pleasantly drying, finally unveiling the merest whisp of peat smoke.

Tomatin 12 YO £4.90
Medium-bodied, well-balanced and quite sweet. There are notes of fudge and dark sugar, winter spice and a touch of vinosity.

Campbeltown

Springbank 10 YO £4.80
A family owned, independent and iconic distillery. A full-bodied malt with a hint of sweetness that increases with age.

Lowland Whisky

Auchentoshan 12 YO £4.80
Tempting aromas of toasted almonds and caramelised toffee are followed by the signature smooth, delicate, Auchentoshan taste.

Glenkinchie 12 YO £4.90
Fragrant aromas with gentle hints of honey. The palate is fruity with a slight hint of Calvados and smoky oak.

Highland

Clynelish 14 YO £5.60
Rather peaty with a sea freshness. Fruity and spicy with malted barley and floral hints.

Dalmore 12 YO £5.60
Aged in sherry casks, it has a powerful nose and is very smooth. Spicy marmalade and heather smoke notes persist into an orange finish. The pride of Whyte & Mackay.

Dalmore 15 YO £7.00
A truly delicious malt; elegant and refined with aromas of dried spice, cloves, cinnamon and ginger combined with hints of Seville oranges

Dalmore Cigar £8.00
Simple, clean and moreish. Caramel, shortbread and coffee rule the nose whilst the palate edges toward burnt cinder toffee balanced by flamed orange zest and integrated sherry.

Dalwhinnie 15 YO £5.00
This is a simple, flawless, clean and crisp malt. Enjoy aromas of heather and a light subtly peated nose.

Deanston 12 yo £5.00
Light aromas of cereal and zesty orange marmalade lead into soft, nutty caramel flavours with a touch of salinity. Finishing softly with a hint of caramel.

Edradour 10 YO £5.00
Delicious honey notes complimented by an oily mouthfeel and a stylish finish.

Glendronach 12 YO £5.00
Rich, creamy and silky-smooth with a full mouthfeel and notes of raisins and soft fruits. Spicy with a medium length and a dry finish.

Glengoyne 10 YO £4.60
From a distillery in the village of Blanefield between Glasgow and Aberfoyle. Slightly lighter in colour, remarkably smooth and fiendishly approachable.

Glenmorangie 10 YO £4.30
Floral with citrus notes and balanced traces of almond and smoky spices.

Highland Continued

Glenmorangie Lasanta £6.50

Finished with both Oloraso and Pedro Ximenez sherry casks and is said to mean 'warmth and passion' in Gaelic.

Glenmorangie Nectar d'Or £7.50

Prominent flavours that roll over the palate are vanilla and subtle lemon along with hints of ginger and nutmeg.

Glenmorangie Quinta Ruben £6.50

A nose full of different berries and port notes with a sweet and thick palate.

Glenrothes Select Reserve £4.90

Lots of zesty, rich fruit on the nose. The palate is smooth with a little vanilla, malt and sumptuous oak. The finish is long with a mocha and barley sweetness.

Oban 14 YO £5.90

A malt with distinct coastal character. Rich and smooth with peaty smokiness and fruity undertones, this is a fine after dinner malt.

Old Pultney 12 YO £5.50

Crisp and clean with great balance revealing notes of herbs with medium body and musty flavours leading into an oaky finish.

Island Malts

Ardbeg 10 YO £5.60

Very Peaty, smoky and complex yet it does not flaunt the peat; rather it gives way to the natural sweetness to produce a whisky of perfect balance.

Bowmore 12 YO £4.80

Complex and subtle with delicious smoky notes and hints of toffee

Bunnahabhain 12 YO £5.60

Light in colour and in body. Slightly salty with just a whiff of smoke

Bruichladdich Classic Laddie £5.60

Clean, fresh and lively with sweet oak and barley in perfect harmony.

Caol Ila 12 YO £5.60

Packing plenty of potent phenols, this is a refined, powerful dram with a compensating oiliness. A balanced, peaty beauty.

Highland Park 12YO £4.50

This classic malt combines island characteristics with Speyside flavours. Smooth and subtle with rich, well balanced malty tones and soft smoke.

Isle of Jura 10 YO £4.40

Light peat and diesel oil on the nose. Relatively light with hints of sweet citrus, ending on a dry, nutty finish.

Lagavulin 16 YO £7.00

A small sip reveals a heady nose with aromas of seaweed and peat smoke. Very thick and rich in taste with a good, fruity sweetness. Powerful and peaty with a complete finish.

Laphroaig 10 YO £4.70

The most strongly peated of all whiskies – bold and smoky with a hint of seaweed and sweetness. This full bodied with a long finish.

Ledaig 10 YO £4.70

Light and well-balanced aromas of soft peat, barley and pine. Medium-bodied with a rich palate of spice, oak and a touch of black pepper.

Skapa Skiren £4.80

Rich with honey warmth and sparks of juicy pear and lemon peel. A touch of oak brings balanced spice to the medium-length, sweet finish.

Smokehead £4.70

A rich, seaweedy and intensely peaty whisky. The flavour is fresh, fruity and immense with notes of sherry, iodine, toffee, smoke and sea salt.

Talisker 10 YO £4.80

A very individual Island malt with an enticing smoky nose and an explosive, smoky-peppery palate that echos through the finish.
