## SPEYSIDE CONT...

### Glenlivet Founder's Reserve

4.60

Full gold in colour, the nose is mellow and sophisticated, backed by a sweet, biscuity note with a remote and elusive fragrance that becomes more floral at reduced strength.

### Knockando 12 YO

5.00

Fragrant and smooth with a delightful, flowery, nutty sweetness, it leaves the palate clean with evanescent, smoky, dry notes.

### Macallan Double Cask

4.70

Citrus and boiled sweets rule the palate, along with hints of ginger and cinnamon, while soft oak tones reveal toasted apples. The finish is medium-sweet, malty and slightly dry.

### Monkey Shoulder

4.70

A smooth, creamy, supple and very malty with a suggestion of berries. Juicy, toasted barley, cloves and butterscotch. Medium length finish with spicy oak and a hint of peppermint on the tail.

### Singleton of Dufftown

5.10

Flavours of orange zest, oak and spice enhanced by lingering, fruity touches.

### Tamdhu 12 YO

5.50

Matured in ex-sherry casks for 12 years, this rich, elegant Tamdhu holds aromas of cinnamon rolls, orange candy, fresh oak, raisins and faint traces of mint. The palate offers notes of banana, raspberry jam, malty biscuits and toasted oak, before developing into ground cinnamon, dried fruit and Scottish tablet flavours that linger in the finish.

### Tomatin 12 YO

5.10

Medium-bodied, well-balanced and quite sweet. There are notes of fudge and dark sugar, winter spice and a touch of vinosity.

## CAMPBELTOWN

### Springbank 10 YO

7.00

A family-owned, independent and iconic distillery. A full-bodied malt with a hint of sweetness that increases with age.

## LOWLAND WHISKY

### Auchentoshan 12 YO

5.00

Tempting aromas of toasted almonds and caramelised toffee are followed by the signature smooth, delicate, Auchentoshan taste.

### Glenkinchie 12 YO

5.50

Fragrant aromas with gentle hints of honey. The palate is fruity with a slight hint of Calvados and smoky oak.

## SCOTTISH GINS

### Botanist

4.00

The aromas leap from the glass with sweet, delicate menthol, apple mint, spring woodland, juniper and coriander. Lemon and orange peel fill the mouth. It's a magical melody of Islay's natural bounty.

### Caorunn

4.00

Perfectly clear like pure Scottish water; dry, crisp and full-bodied with a long, dry finish. An aromatic taste adventure – fresh, floral, citrusy and slightly spicy.

### Edinburgh

3.80

A big juniper Gin with a distinctively Scottish twist. On the nose is juniper and pine with citrus (lemon) notes.

### Edinburgh Raspberry

3.70

Intensely fruity liqueur, packed with the summer's juiciest raspberries.

### Edinburgh Plum & Vanilla

3.70

Plum & Vanilla is a luxurious, velvety liqueur balancing juicy plum fruit flavours with delicate Madagascan vanilla.

### Edinburgh Pomegranate & Rose

3.70

A delicately sweet liqueur, abundant with floral aromas.

### Edinburgh Rhubarb & Ginger

3.70

A classic pairing, Rhubarb & Ginger is a sweet, fruity liqueur balanced by a delicate warmth and spicy finish.

### Hendrick's

4.00

Made with a delicious duet of infusions rose petal and cucumber. Very light and fresh-smelling. Delicate juniper leads to a savoury and lime cordial-led aroma with an understated floral influence. Initially smooth, but becoming spicier towards the finish.

### Inshriach

4.50

The Inshriach Distillery not only makes smashing gins - they're also winner of Shed of the Year 2015! Their Inshriach Original Gin boasts fresh floral sweetness and hints of peppery juniper.

### Rock Rose

4.00

A vibrant, well-balanced and complex Gin, with fruity berries with hints of citrus. Named after the distillers first botanical forage which discovered a rose nestled in the rocks of the Caithness cliffs.

### Kinrara

3.90

Warming pine and juicy blueberry, followed by a touch of orange pith.

### Kinrara Hibiscus



Delicately fruity and floral, with a bright citrus undertone.

### Shetland Reel

4.20

The nose has a hint of juniper with a subtle mix of spices and citrus. The initial palate has juniper, mixed spice, sweetness with a citrus tang and a refreshing hint of mint at the end. The finish is clean and fresh.

## ISLAND WHISKY

<b>Ardbeg 10 YO</b>	<b>£5.80</b>
Very peaty, smoky and complex yet it does not flaunt the peat; rather it gives way to natural sweetness to produce a whisky of perfect balance.	
<b>Bowmore 12 YO</b>	<b>5.00</b>
Complex and subtle with delicious smoky notes and hints of toffee.	
<b>Bunnahabhain 12 YO</b>	<b>5.80</b>
Light in colour and in body. Slightly salty with just a whiff of smoke.	
<b>Bruichladdich Classic Laddie</b>	<b>5.80</b>
Clean, fresh and lively with sweet oak and barley in perfect harmony.	
<b>Caol Ila 12 YO</b>	<b>5.80</b>
Packing plenty of potent phenols, this is a refined, powerful dram with a compensating oiliness. A balanced, peaty beauty.	
<b>Highland Park 12 YO</b>	<b>4.70</b>
This classic malt combines island characteristics with Speyside flavours. Smooth and subtle with rich, well-balanced, malty tones and soft smoke.	
<b>Isle of Jura 10 YO</b>	<b>4.60</b>
Light peat and diesel oil on the nose. Relatively light with hints of sweet citrus, ending on a dry, nutty finish.	
<b>Lagavulin 16 YO</b>	<b>10.00</b>
A small sip reveals a heady nose with aromas of seaweed and peat smoke. Very thick and rich in taste with a good, fruity sweetness. Lagavulin is a traditional Gaelic whisky, powerful and peaty with a complete finish.	
<b>Laphroaig 10 YO</b>	<b>4.90</b>
The most strongly peated of all whiskies – bold and smoky with a hint of seaweed and sweetness. This full-bodied variant is the foundation of all Laphroaig expressions and comes with a long finish.	
<b>Ledaig 10 YO</b>	<b>4.90</b>
Light and well-balanced aromas of soft peat, barley and pine. Medium-bodied with a rich palate of spice, oak and a touch of black pepper.	
<b>Scapa Skiren</b>	<b>5.00</b>
Rich with a honey warmth and sparks of juicy pear and lemon peel. A touch of oak brings balanced spice to the medium-length, sweet finish.	
<b>Smokehead</b>	<b>4.90</b>
Smokehead is a rich, seaweedy and intensely peaty whisky. The flavour is fresh, fruity and immense with notes of sherry, iodine, toffee, smoke and sea salt.	
<b>Talisker 10 YO</b>	<b>5.00</b>
A very individual Island malt with an enticing smoky nose and an explosive, smoky-peppery palate that echoes through the finish.	

## HIGHLAND

<b>Clynelish 14 YO</b>	<b>5.80</b>
Rather peaty with a sea freshness. Fruity and spicy with malted barley and floral hints.	
<b>Dalmore 12 YO</b>	<b>6.50</b>
Aged in sherry casks, it has a powerful nose and is very smooth. Spicy marmalade and heather smoke notes persist into an orange finish. The pride of Whyte and Mackay.	
<b>Dalmore Cigar</b>	<b>11.00</b>
Simple, clean and moreish. Caramel, shortbread and coffee rule the nose whilst the palate edges towards burnt cinder-toffee balanced by flamed orange zest and integrated sherry.	
<b>Dalmore 15 YO</b>	<b>9.00</b>
A truly delicious malt; elegant and refined with aromas of dried spice, cloves, cinnamon and ginger combined with hints of Seville oranges.	
<b>Dalwhinnie 15 YO</b>	<b>5.20</b>
Awarded 95 points by Jim Murray in his Whisky Bible, this is a simple, flawless, clean and crisp malt. Enjoy aromas of heather and a light, subtly peaty nose.	
<b>Deanston 12 YO</b>	<b>5.20</b>
Light aromas of cereal and zesty orange marmalade lead into soft, nutty caramel flavours with a touch of salinity. Finishing softly with a hint of caramel.	
<b>Edradour 10 YO</b>	<b>5.20</b>
Delicious honey notes complemented by an oily mouthfeel and a stylish finish.	
<b>Glendronach 12 YO</b>	<b>5.20</b>
Rich, creamy and silky-smooth with a full mouthfeel and notes of raisins and soft fruits. Spicy with medium length and a dry finish.	
<b>Glenfiddich 10 YO</b>	<b>4.80</b>
From a distillery situated near the village of Blane near Glasgow and Aberfoyle. Slightly lighter in colour, remarkably smooth and fiendishly approachable.	
<b>Glenmorangie 10 YO</b>	<b>4.50</b>
Floral with citrus notes and balanced traces of almond and smoky spices.	
<b>Glenmorangie Lasanta</b>	<b>6.70</b>
Lasanta is finished in both Oloroso and Pedro Ximénez sherry casks and is said to mean ‘warmth and passion’ in Gaelic.	
<b>Glenmorangie Nectar d’Or</b>	<b>7.70</b>
Prominent flavours that roll over the palate are vanilla and subtle lemon, along with hints of ginger and nutmeg, especially towards the finish.	
<b>Glenmorangie Quinta Ruban</b>	<b>6.70</b>
A nose full of different berries and port notes with a sweet and thick palate.	
<b>Glenrothes 12 YO</b>	<b>5.10</b>
Matured only in sherry seasoned oak casks and bottled at natural colour with a character of vanilla, melon, and cinnamon.	
<b>Oban 14 YO</b>	<b>10.00</b>
A malt with a distinct coastal character. Rich and smooth with peaty smokiness and fruity undertones, this is a fine after-dinner malt.	
<b>Old Pulteney 12 YO</b>	<b>5.70</b>
Crisp and clean with great balance revealing notes of herbs with medium body and musty flavours leading into an oaky finish.	

## SPEYSIDE

<b>The Cairngorm Malt</b>	<b>4.20</b>
A single malt whisky distilled at Tomintoul distillery which is situated on the Glenlivet estate. It displays all the hallmarks of a Speyside malt whisky – light and delicate with a warming glow. *Remember, if you would like to take home, you can buy a bottle as a souvenir for €39.00	
<b>Aberlour 12 YO</b>	<b>6.00</b>
This double matured version is a mix of traditional oak and sherry casks and is rich and fruity with delicious Christmas cake notes.	
<b>Beinn Dubh</b>	<b>6.00</b>
Dried fruits, some woodsmoke and a kind of dry, black treacle note on the nose with cinnamon, blackstrap molasses and treacle on the palate.	
<b>Balvenie 12 YO</b>	<b>5.20</b>
Deep amber in colour. Re-racked in oloroso sherry casks to give a sherry nose with a nutty, malty finish.	
<b>Balvenie 14 YO</b>	<b>6.50</b>
Matured for fourteen years in traditional oak casks before being transferred to Caribbean Rum casks to create a well-rounded and drinkable Whisky with notes of fruit and vanilla.	
<b>Cardhu 12 YO</b>	<b>5.25</b>
Shows a good body, sweet and rich. Streaks of smoke, apple peel and pear. The palate is smooth, rounded and gentle. On the finish – long, dry smoke and a malty touch of peat.	
<b>Cragganmore 12 YO</b>	<b>5.20</b>
A rich, slightly floral whisky with barley notes on the nose. A strong, malty taste with hints of sweet wood smoke and sandalwood followed by a long, malt-driven finish with light smoke and hints of sweetness.	
<b>Glenfarclas 10 YO</b>	<b>4.70</b>
Home to an independent family since 1865 in the valley of the green grass, this is a firm, slightly smoky malt. Dry at first and then blossoming into a sweet, long finish.	
<b>Glenfarclas 105</b>	<b>7.00</b>
The strongest single malt offered by any distillery. Full-bodied and rich with nuances of butterscotch and raisins followed by a long, powerful finish boosted by the strength of the cask.	
<b>Glenfarclas 15 YO</b>	<b>7.00</b>
With great age, comes great complexity. A prime balance of sherry, oak and smokiness makes this a superb malt.	
<b>Glenfiddich 12 YO</b>	<b>4.70</b>
The Valley of the Deer gives its name to this global big-seller. Light in style with sweet, fruity notes and a hint of pear on the nose followed with a trace of smokiness in its aromatic flavour.	
<b>Glenfiddich 15 YO</b>	<b>5.50</b>
This medium-bodied malt supports the Christmas pudding flavours – sherry, raisins, fruitcake, spices and sweetness – preceding an oaky finish.	
<b>Glenfiddich IPA</b>	<b>6.00</b>
Vibrant with a zesty citrus note followed by creamy vanilla and a hint of fresh hops.	
<b>Glenfiddich Project XX</b>	<b>5.20</b>
Lots of wood: cloves, cinnamon and vanilla with tingly wood tannins, all wrapped up with some sweet fudge notes.	
<b>Glenfiddich Fire &amp; Cane</b>	<b>5.20</b>
Like a Highland peat campfire, with oak notes and toffee. Sharp green fruit, sweet baked apple and soft smoke.
